Project Background and Analysis	From the study analysis of Shijak Functional Area, it results that the LGUS's in the area, do not carry out hospital services in the hospital of Shijak; among other reasons, it's because the ambulatory service and specialized personnel to provide the service are almost completely lacking. The means of transport in the hospital of Shijak are either not functioning, or they very consumed to be at the service of the community. As a consequence, this transport is carried out with occasional automobiles. In this situation, taking into consideration that 4 LGU's will be part of only one unit, need arises for provision of the hospital of Shijak, as the main institution in charge of all the population of the area, with appropriate means of transport for patients: 5 ambulances.
Specific Objectives of the Project	Through this project, it is aimed to improve the health service and specifically the ambulatory one at the Functional Area of Shijak.
Expected Results	All the LGU's of Shijak Functional Area (four ones) equally benefit from this

tional Area (four ones) equally benefit from this project. All the community living in Shijak Functional Area (27,861 inhabitants) is a beneficiary of this project. Specifically, the hospital and its ambulatory service improve their service to the patients in all the Functional Area territory, contributing to the improvement of services to the local population.

### Financial Resources and Implementation Partners

Taking into consideration the lack of financial sources for the local government to fund this kind of projects, it would be appropriate to require funding from foreign donors and funds on regional development of the Albanian Government. The procurement unit at the Ministry of Health is the appropriate structure for the implementation of this project.

Tendering and purchase of 5 ambulances for the hospital of Shijak 300,000€; Relevant staff training 43,000€; Total 343,000€.
